PaCE Activity	Grade Level	Who should be the employers partner?	Examples of how employers could support the activity
Attend a career exploration day	8	Middle School	Host booth at career exploration day; Serve as a presenter; Offer company tours after the event
Be exposed to a finance literacy unit in a course or workshop	8	Middle School	Offer a financial literacy workshop; be a guest speaker on personal finance
A student should know the importance of community service and extracurricular activities to PS and career plans	9	High School	Offer presentation on career development; participate in Q&A
Visit at least one workplace aligned to career interests	10	High School	Host field trips and offer company tours to students; Offer job shadow opportunities
Identify 2-3 adults to support him/her through the college and career selection process	10	High School	Be available to serve as a mentor
A student should know educational requirements, cost, expected entry level, and midpoint salary for occupation in selected CP	10	High School	Provide presentation offering career information; participate in Q&A
Participate in a mock job interview	11	High School	Provide presentation on interviewing skills; Participate in mock interviews with students and provide feedback
Create a resume and personal statement	11	High School	Provide presentation on resume skills; Attend resume workshop and provide feedback to students

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Identify an internship opportunity related to CP	11	High School	Develop promotional materials outlining internship opportunities through organization; Offer company tours; provide opportunities for temporary employment
A student should know app deadlines, test timing, cost, and prep for industry-based certification for CP	11	High School	Provide presentation offering career information; participate in Q&A - online or in person
A student should know career attributes related to career interests	11	High School	Provide presentation offering career information; participate in Q&A; allow students to interview current employees; provide opportunities for job shadowing
Obtain an internship related to CP	12	High School	Offer internship opportunities for 12th grade students through organization; Provide supervision and mentorship
If applicable, receive industry-based certification(s) relating to CP	12	High School	Opportunities for internships; classroom talks; workshops for students in the program or who have indicated an interest in the career pathway
Complete one or more team-based challenges or projects relating to CP	12	High School	Serve as presenter/facilitator/mentor for team projects; Attend project presentation and offer feedback
